We are pleased to introduce Responcity, a unique program for fostering civic engagement.

As you can see in the video, Responcity started in Israel. Now it's expanding globally, and we invite you to join students all over the world who are making a difference.

How does it work? The program is divided into three stages.

Stage 1: Learning the language and concepts of the three pillars:

- The Common Good
- The City
- Responsibility and Public Responsibility

Stage 2: Putting theory into practice through Problem-Based Learning (PBL) and solutionseeking techniques

- Form working groups
- Identify a problem/need in the community
- Conduct in-depth research
- Work in teams with a mentor to formulate a solution
- Develop plans for implementation

Stage 3: Implementation

- Prepare a high-level presentation of the ideas
- Present the ideas to municipal leaders at an end-of-year symposium
- Work with municipal authorities to bring the proposed ideas to fruition
- Conduct a pilot program when relevant
- Implement projects approved by the municipality

What skills will students learn?

- Collaboration
- Innovation
- Problem solving
- Communication
- Digital literacy



What else will students gain?

- Acquire the tools to become a responsible "solutionary."
- Realize that they can bring about change and make a difference.
- Build trust.
- Good citizenship.
